

**THE MINUTES

MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF NORTHPORT
RUGULAR MEETING
6:00 PM.**

Present: Mayor Doll, Trustees Maline, Milligan, McMullen and Tobin, Village Clerk Donna Koch, Village Administrator Tim Brojer, Village Attorney Stuart Besen, Police Chief Ric Bruckenthal.

ANNOUNCEMENTS: no announcements.

PRESENTATIONS: no presentations.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION:

Noelle Stegner of Northport and her parents addressed the Board on a proposal to allow Sony PlayStation hold an event in the Village Park. Stating that Noelle has won a video competition and Sony wants to come in and honor her. The idea would be for a large tractor trailer with play stations inside to set up in the park along with a stage set up in the center lawn. Sony would pay ant costs the Village incurs. Advertising would be wide spread (facebook, radio etc.) they expect roughly 600 people. They would like to do it August 1, 2015. Sony would not be selling any games time or other merchandise at this event. The Board felt this was too soon and asked the Village Attorney to contact the Sony representative and see if other dates are available.

COMMISSIONER REPORTS: Trustee Maline reported he has a couple of personal issues for executive session.

Trustee McMullen reported National Water Main has been busy televising the sewer lines and coming to the conclusion that more people need to clean out their laterals which are getting clogged with tree roots. Also on Drone legislation the Village cannot enact its own legislation that would have to come from the FAA.

Trustee Tobin reported he and Village Treasurer Len Marchese have had a conference call with Suffolk Count to move along the pass through money regarding the Waste Water Treatment Plant upgrade.

Trustee Milligan reported he and the chamber have put together packets to hand out to boaters coming into the Village. Also people are very happy with the new ladders installed earlier this summer.

Mayor Doll reported Highway has been busy with trees, mowing, line painting, the jet vac has been out. They helped with barricades for the Fourth of July fireworks with Asharoken and have done some guard rail repair.

CHIEF OF POLICE REPORT: Chief Bruckenthal reported the department responded to 504 calls for service, issued 207 summonses, made 19 arrests, 3 which were for DWI.
