Incident: Two hour parking Location: Northport Village Date/Time: June 1, 2017

As a result of the concerns of many of the merchants in the downtown business district in the Village of Northport, on June 1, 2017 the Northport Police Department will begin strictly enforcing the two (2) hour limit for parking at metered spots.

Section 282-35 of the Northport Village Code limits the time a vehicle can be parked at a metered parking spot to two (2) hours. This two hour limit is in effect seven days a week with no exceptions between 8am and 6pm. A vehicle may only be parked in a metered spot for two consecutive hours and adding coins to the meter beyond the two hours **does not** extend the time limit.

Coins must be inserted into the meters between 8am and 6pm Monday – Saturday. The meters are not in effect Sundays and holidays, however, as mentioned above the two hour limit is, at metered spots.

Longer term parking is available in both parking lots at the end of Main Street, the parking lot on the corner of Woodbine and Scudder Avenues, the lot on Woodside Avenue by the American Legion and at any street parking spot that is not metered or otherwise restricted by a sign.

By strictly enforcing the two hour limit at metered spots, we hope to provide adequate and more available parking for the customers of our downtown businesses thus creating a more inviting shopping experience.
