FILE 19-24 – 809 FT. SALONGA RD. – THE LIVING ROOM

Carl Horn from Eclipse Sign appeared before the board to request permission to install new signs at 809 Ft. Salonga Rd. The signs will say The Living Room Wellness Store. The post and panel sign will also say CBD Education & Consulting. The sign on the building will be black individual letters and will be centered above the windows. The street sign will have a white background with green and black trim and letters. Both signs were approved based on submitted drawings. Gary Blake made a motion for approval which was seconded by Steve King.

FILE 19-25 – 162 MAIN ST. – FIREFLY ARTISTS

Katie Laible a representative from Firefly Artists submitted an application to change the color of the existing awning from purple to turquoise to match the door color at 162 Main St. Gary Blake made the motion to approve this change which Brendan Moran seconded.

FILE 19-26 – 67 MAIN ST. – HYDRANGEA HOME

Fred Mohrmann submitted an application to install two new signs at 67 Main St. The building sign will be hung at the storefront entry and will use the existing sign brackets. The sign will be 32” high x 68” wide. The entry sign will be constructed from stained lumber and will then have an oval shaped area outlined in brass tacks. It will say Hydrangea in allura font with white letters with Home in Caligula dodgy font also painted white. The background for the oval will be grey and have a darker grey hydrangea logo above the lettering. The blade sign will match the entry sign but will be 12” x 20” installed on the existing bracket to the left of the entry door. The resolution was offered by Andrea Miller and seconded by Rich Krulik.
