Public Portion of Meeting

File #1402 – 42 Thomas Lane

Applicant, Frank Behr, appeared before the Board to request a variance to construct a second-floor addition/alteration to the dwelling. Additional Exhibits were entered into the record, Exhibit #9 – Rendering of Addition, Exhibit #10 – Letter of Support From Neighbor, Exhibit #11 – Rendering of Elevator. When testimony was complete, all were given the opportunity to speak before the hearing was closed.

File #1401 – 81A Fort Salonga Road

Applicant, Sosh Andriano, and Attorney, James Margolin, appeared before the Board to address the Notice of Violation/Notice to Cure issued to the Harbor Head Brewery by the Village of Northport. Additional Exhibits were entered into the record, Exhibit #12 - Village Code Section for Marine Business District and Exhibit #13 - Village Code Section for Breweies. Hearing was left open to allow time for the Brewery's violations pending before Village Court and the Notice of Default between Harbor Head Brewery and their landlord to be resolved.
