Chief Sheridan:

New stabilizing jacks for motor vehicle accidents were received. They will schedule a practice to train everyone on the safe and proper operation.

Department purchased a new refrigerator for the rear utility room. They would like to have an exhaust fan installed to reduce amount of heat buildup. Board approves expenditure.

Also approved is the purchase of a battery-operated exhaust fan for the 298 truck same unit they have on the 297 and a fire extinguisher to be mounted on the officer's side of the 293.

Status of purchase of desktop computer for the Hook & Ladder officers work area. Phil Weber said it has been ordered.

Request to purchase uniform supplies, shirts, shoes, belts, ties and badges. The Quartermaster will prepare a list. Board approves expenditure.

Joe Pansini will be heading a radio committee.

There are some outstanding invoices from All American Uniforms & Awards. Chief Smalling paid an Invoice in the amount of \$300.27 out of his own pocket and needs to be reimbursed.

Gaps in paramedic coverage need to be addressed.
