Electronics (E-Waste) Recycling

New York State has an NYS e-waste law. This law mandates that residents may not place electronic waste at the curb for pickup. NYS law now requires manufacturers to take responsibility for the recycling of the electronic equipment that they produce. Manufacturers must provide free and convenient acceptance programs for NYS consumers to properly reuse and/or recycle their waste electronic equipment. The law specifically prohibits all consumers from disposing of all covered electronic equipment in landfills or any other disposal site. Village residents can recycle their intact electronic items at <u>Scudder Park</u> on Tuesdays from 8am-3pm, and Saturdays from 8am-12pm. Residents may also drop of items at the Town of Huntington Recycling Center (631-446-3653 or 631-427-6377) located at 641 New York Avenue, Huntington, NY 11743 from Tuesday through Saturday, 8am-3:45pm.

The following items may be dropped off:

- Televisions
- Monitors
- Computers
- Computer peripherals (including any cable, cord or wiring affixed to or incorporated into the computer)
- Computer mice
- Fax machines, document scanners and printers (weight must be under 100 lbs.)
- VCRs
- DVD players
- Portable digital music players (Ipods and the like)
- Digital video recorders
- Digital converter boxes
- Cable or satellite receivers
- Video game consoles

*** Please note that small electric appliances are not to be recycled at these facilities. For instance, please do not bring any vacuum cleaners, toasters, toaster ovens, mixers, microwave ovens and other household appliances to the E-waste facility. ***
