

Northport Menorah Lighting

Our tradition of lighting Northport's Chanukah menorah continues this year. Everyone is welcome to join us.

Located on the lower Main Street, by the harbor, the menorah will be lit at 7 pm each of the eight nights of Chanukah. Those nights are Monday, December 14th to December 22nd. The East Northport Jewish Center will be leading the lighting ceremony Monday, December 15th.

Chanukah, the festival of lights, represents religious freedom. It celebrates when the Temple in Jerusalem was re-dedicated in 139 BCE after being taken back from the Syrian – Greek occupiers, allowing Jewish worship to begin again.
